Great Fire of London: Key Stage 1

Cut out flashcards

Provide each student with a sheet of flashcards.

- Encourage them to cut them all out on the dotted lines.
- Once cut out students can sort each card into equipment used in the Great Fire of London and equipment used in the modern day.
- Develop some simple games such as: snap, memory game, spot the difference etc.
- The cards are a great opportunity to discuss the difference in equipment used to fight fires in the past and how equipment has changed and developed.

Circle time

Using the larger flashcards, in-cooperate them into a circle time discussion.

• As a class, organise the cards into equipment used in the Great Fire of London and equipment used in modern day firefighting.


Once organised discuss safety questions such as:

- Why do you think it took so long to put the fire out with the old equipment?
- Do you think old firefighter's uniform was safe? Why?
- Using equipment we have today would it have helped stop the fire spreading across London? Why?


